## THE SERMON ON THE MOUNTAIN

Matthew 5:1-14

**D**ELIVERANCE FROM poverty is paramount in the agenda of Jesus Christ and it is next to deliverance from sin in the package of salvation. **Poverty means lack and suffering.** It can lead to insanity. When the blessing of God appears, poverty disappears. God wants His children to be blessed (Haggai 2:8, Philippians 4:19). Jesus Christ was anointed to deliver His people from all manners of poverty (Luke 4:18), this why Jesus Christ's sermon on the mountain centres on blessing.

4. Those that do hunger and thirst after righteousness (Matt 5:6).

Those who hunger and thirst for righteousness are those who hold steadfastly unto God in faith under any circumstance. They are people that will never compromise the will of God because of money. God says they shall be blessed this year.

5. Those who are merciful shall obtain mercy and be blessed (Matt 5:7).

You can show mercy by clothing people who are naked, feeding people who are hungry, providing for the needy, blessing somebody who works for God but lack. Whatever you sow, you shall reap (Galatians 6:7). If you do not correct your children or other children with love, you are not enforcing discipline but you are wicked! Show mercy to others so that God will show you mercy this year.

6. Those who are pure in heart are blessed, for they shall see God (Matt 5:8; Psalm 24:3-4). This means having good thoughts about others. Wicked people do not wish others well. If your heart is pure, you shall be blessed this year.

### Who are those that God will bless?

1. Those who are poor in spirit (Matt. 5:3).

The poor in Spirit are those that are poor (humble) but have Holy Spirit. He says He will give prosperity to the poor (humble) believers and turn their story to glory this year (Luke 4:18).

2. Those that mourn (Matt 5:4).

Those that are sorrowful in heart. For whatever may be the challenge that is making you to mourn silently, Jesus Christ (The Comforter) says He is comforting you this year.

3. The meek (Matt 5:5).

These are the gentle, oppressed and that cannot fight for themselves; Jesus says He will fight for them and they will inherit the

## THE GLORY OF GOD - II Key Scripture: Psalm 19:1

### ...Last Week

We learnt that GLORY is God's property and it can neither be destroyed nor altered by any being. God is the King of Glory - Psalm 24:8 and whatsoever He does remains unchanged - Ecclesiastes 3:14. All glories have their lights from God's Glory - Psalm 36:9

### B. Differences between Glory and Destiny

Destiny defines the right pathway to Glory. A destination does not necessarily end in glory, but if it glorious in the end, that is destiny achieved – Psalm 73:24.

1. It is the result	It is the process	John 12:24

3. Unique	May be common	John 17:5; Ecclesiastes 9:2

5. God's property	Man's experience	Psalm 24:8; Ecclesiastes 3:14

### C. Types of Glory

God is a constant God of endless possibilities. He created ALL things, yet in their glories and powers without undue oppression and suppression on each other - Genesis 1:31 - *And God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good (suitable, pleasant) and He approved it completely...AMP.* It is in this unimaginable and immeasurable potency that God made the glories differ in their classes and grades -

1. Natural Glories – of the Sun, Moon, Stars – 1 Corinthians 15:41; Psalm 8:5
2. Earthly Glories – of Men, Animals and Plants
3. Angelic Glories – Psalm 103:20; 78:19-25; 2 Kings 19:35
4. Glory of Man – Psalm 8:4-6
5. Glory of God – Most inexplicable and immeasurable yet unmistakably visible – Psalm 19:1.
  - a. It speaks of God's awesome and infinite strengths – Psalm 97.
  - b. His Glory is the Light of the light of men – Psalm 36:9.
  - c. Majestic display of authority and power – Exodus 14:4; 15:9-12
