## DELIVERANCE & ANOINTING SERVICE

Sermon

Text

### UNDER THE MANAGEMENT OF JESUS CHRIST

Matthew 11:28-30

There is a manager for everything and every man on earth, and the success of everything or man is determined by the manager. Jesus is the best Manager ever in the world.

According to this Bible passage, Jesus Christ calls on people who are suffering and having different challenges to bring their challenges under His management. He makes a call to everyone on earth to come under His management with their challenges. **When you allow Jesus to manage your life, success and victory is certain.**

It is Satan that manages some peoples' lives and teaches them how to steal, kill, and destroy (John 10:10); the end is destruction. Saul was under the management of Satan (killing people around) before he became Paul under the management of Jesus Christ (Acts 9). Judas Iscariot allowed himself to be managed by Satan, and he ended up in destruction.

#### Under the management of Jesus...

**1. There will be no challenge or difficulty for man in life** - This is because with Jesus, ALL things are possible (Matthew 19:26; Mark 10:27; Luke 18:27). With man, there is limitation, but under the management of Jesus, there is no limitation, failure or disappointment. The moment Peter came under the management of Jesus Christ, as a fisherman, his fruitlessness, failure, and disappointment turned to great success and glory (Luke 5:3-7).

**2. There is healing.** The woman with the issue of blood had sought for solution everywhere for 12 years to no avail, but when she came under the management of Jesus, she received instant healing (Luke 8:43-48). Bartimaeus came under His

management and his destiny received a turnaround (Mark 10:46-52).

**3. There is hope for someone that has been rejected.** Under His management, the stone that the builders have rejected becomes the cornerstone of the house (Psalm 118:22-23). Under His management, there is hope for the widow and orphan. Ruth's hope in Almighty God made her become the great grandmother of Jesus (Ruth 1-4; Matthew 1:5).

**4. Every protocol is broken, irrespective of your age.** At a very old age, Sarah conceived and bore a baby under the management of the Almighty God. As a virgin, Mary thought it was not possible for her to conceive, but under the management of Holy Ghost, she became the mother of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**5. The irreversible is reversed.**

**6. There is no condemnation** (Romans 8:1). Your past has nothing to do when you come under the management of Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:17). Rahab was a harlot, but when she came under the management of Jesus, her story changed from shame to glory as she became the great grandmother of Jesus. The story of the 'prodigal son' changed to glory when he came back under the management of Jesus through his father (Luke 15).

**7. Every power surrenders.** Since all powers belong to Him (Matthew 28:18), therefore all powers in heaven, on earth, and under the earth including the powers of witches, wizards, marine, occultist, etc. must surrender to Him (Philippians 2:10-11; Romans 14:11).

## THE OLD PROPHETS - study series

**Key Scripture:**  
Galatians 1:8

Central Text: 1 Kings 13

### • Key Characters

LET us note these key characters here -

- \* The Man of God - a.k.a. 'the young Prophet'.
- \* King Jeroboam - the unrepentant king.
- \* The Altar of sacrifice - polluted altar.
- \* Josiah - the promised new born king.
- \* The Old Prophet
- \* Sons of Old Prophet

An "Old Prophet" was once vibrant and dynamic oracle of God who now carelessly lives compromising lifestyles although he still operates under the cloak of his calling but with yesterday's glory and power - Romans 11:29.

### • Characteristics of Old Prophets

Let us examine some of these behaviours especially as shown by other deceptive ministers.

#### 1. They become insensitive to the move of God.

The Old Prophet lived in Beth-El (House of God) under an irreverent King Jeroboam - 1 Kings 14:7-9 but could not caution the king. It is possible that this Old Prophet might have done one, all or more of the following:

- Taken bribe from people of the land,
- Compromised judgement from God,
- Lowered his guards of authority,
- Mingled with the unholy sect.

Recall Prophet Eli at his latter days in 1 Samuel 2 -

If you are in Him and He is in you, no power of the world can overcome you (1 John 4:4).

**8. He will baptize you with Holy Spirit** and you will begin to say the truth (Romans 9:1).

**9. There is grace, favour, good health, prosperity, and joy.** Every man is secured under the management of Jesus and none can die as a failure (Hebrews 4:16).

Brethren, who is managing your life? Whose voice are you hearing? Is it the voice of Jesus or that of

- He compromised God's standard in child discipline - verse 17.

- He cared for other families more than his own - verse 20.

- He could not control his house nor the land of Israel - verse 23-25

- He became dull of hearing from God and God devised another means to reach him in 1 Samuel 2:27; 3:17

- He lost his role as Prophet in the land - 1 Samuel 4:4

#### 2. They Rest after the Test.

A man loses strength not because he has fought a battle but because he does not re-train himself after he dispenses his energy. Jesus Christ would refrain from the public after ministering to people and will pray all-night for the next day. Luke 6:12.

This is a pattern all ministers of God should emulate especially after discharging their duties - Colossians 4:2.

The Old Prophet would rather be updated by his sons - 1 Kings 13:11. It was usual for the 'Old Prophet' to rest or refresh at a spot - 1 Kings 13:15 but read 1 Corinthians 10:23-24.

### Conclusion

We shall discuss more of the characteristics of Old Prophets in next week Bible Study. Let us Pray. 🎵
