Text

THE GOD THAT SUPPLIES ALL NEEDS

Philippians 4:13-19

Bare economic principle, human needs are unlimited and his wants are insatiable. The richest man on earth does not have the ability to supply all the needs of people in a single village in the world.

However, Apostle Paul told the Philippians *'but my God will supply ALL your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus - verse 19.* Is your need a job, house, car, money, airplane, husband, wife, children, or everything together? They are nothing before God. This implies that God has all the riches both in heaven and on earth, and He is the Owner and Provider of wealth for all. He has the power to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think - Ephesians 3:20.

WHAT ARE MAN'S NEEDS?

1. Healing, peace, and joy

God is the Great Healer, no matter what the sickness or affliction is, He will give you the healing you need - 1 Peter 2:24; Isaiah 53:5, and prosper you with good health (3 John 2). Some people have good health, but no peace; God will heal you and give you peace and joy.

2. Uncommon connection

Every man needs to be connected to helper of destiny. Peter's business did not prosper until he encountered Jesus - his destiny helper (Luke 5:5-7). The chief Butler was the helper of destiny that God connected with Joseph in the prison (Genesis 40:9).

Some people need to be connected with their Prophet just as David was connected with Samuel (1 Samuel 16:13). Without King Ahasuerus, Esther might not fulfill her destiny, and without Esther, Mordecai might die as a Gateman (Esther 2:17; 4, 5, 6). Also, a Ministry needs both financial and spiritual generals as helpers of destiny.

3. Uncommon Power

People need different kinds of power in life, such as physical, material, political, educational, and spiritual power. Spiritual power is the greatest asset a man can possess. Some people lack spiritual power, the reason



enemies come around to scatter whatever they have gathered. Some people have prosperity, stars and glory, but do not have spiritual power to secure them. This is why the Lord makes His ministers flame of fire (Power) because He knows they are the targets of enemies (Hebrews 1:7; Psalm 104:4; Deuteronomy 8:18; Acts 1:8).

Finally, the greatest thing that God gives man and no one else can give is SALVATION (John 3:16). No man can forgive sins and iniquities except Jesus Christ

THE OLD PROPHETS - Study 5

Key Scripture:
Galatians 5:13 ; 1 Kings 13

MISSIONS OF THE OLD PROPHETS (CONT'D)

2. To create the fear of man in place of the fear of God

Up till the time of the prophecy against the altar in Bethel, the old prophet was the symbol of authority. He had his sons everywhere in the land to feed him back and possibly use the 'info' to deliver speeches in the name of 'prophecy' - 1 Kings 13:11. This was unlike Elisha who needed not be with the Arameans to know their plots against Israel - 2 Kings 6:8-23. The Arameans testified to the omnipresence of God - 2 Kings 6:12.

The fear of God does not make us become afraid of God but gives us boldness

When such 'Old Prophets' speak, they speak so convincingly and to manipulate, so beware!

Caution Note

The man of God feared and believed in the Old Prophet more than God's Words.

3. To celebrate past victories as the ultimate achievements

Old Prophets prefer to recount and celebrate the past glorious years of their achievements; nothing new in them again! Such concepts often produce complacency and limitations.

Victories of yesterday should turn to praises for greater victory tomorrow.

David rather recounted his past victories to achieve the present victory - 1 Samuel 17:34-37. God's goodness is always new every day, so celebrate today's goodness for greater mercies

(1 John 1:7).

If you want God to meet your needs, you need to make giving (offering, tithe, first fruit) your lifestyle; if you are not a giver,

tomorrow. There is always a higher level - Psalm 84:7.

Caution Note

The man of God 'recognised' the Old Prophet in the land and believed his testimony! He was eventually drifted from his foundation into fables - 2 Timothy 4:4.

4. To terminate bright visions (star and glory) - Ephesians 4:14

The old prophet saw himself as the ultimate visionary in the land and any upcoming bright 'visions' would be cunningly suppressed. Recall Eliab's over-reaction to David at the war zone - 1 Samuel 17:28 and his previous rejection by God - 1 Samuel 16:7.

Likewise, the old prophet knew the interpretation and implications of the prophecies and signs from the man of God from Judah. Just like Joseph's brothers in Genesis 37:20. This was why he ensured that the young prophet worked against his vision - 1 Kings 13:19.

Caution Note

The man of God shared his entire mission and vision with the old prophet. His bright destiny was exchanged for a soon-to-fade version! Did he have to narrate all the details to the old prophet? Read 2 Kings 20:12-18 and Luke 2:19
