Sermon ▶ THE RESURRECTION POWER

Philippians 3:7-11

Text ▲

WHAT DOES this Power mean?

1. Resurrection power is the power that overcomes death in any form.

It is the Power of God to search for anything taken by death and bring it back to life - Psalm 49:6-9; Ecclesiastes 8:8.

Death has no respect for whoever its victim is or wherever he is, its mandate is to take life. Glory means nothing to death; it is time-bound which means that none has the power to prevent it or pay its price when it comes EXCEPT the resurrection power that is over and above death.

After Adams and Eve sinned in the Garden of Eden, God gave power to death, but He reserved the Power of Resurrection, which is the ONLY Power that conquers death. After Jesus Christ has died for our redemption, God brought out the Power of Resurrection.

Abraham- the father of faith, Solomon with all his wealth, and others were all conquered by death; BUT JESUS CHRIST was given the resurrection power to conquer death and come out the grave.

2. Resurrection power means coming out of the grave.

Jesus went to the grave and conquered death and thereafter, many saints that have died were raised - Matthew 27:52-53; Colossians 1:18.

3. Resurrection power means setting the captives free.

There is liberty by the Power of Resurrection - Ephesians 4:8.

4. Resurrection power connotes excellence and success.

The excellent power of resurrection would have as well brought Jesus out of the grave without the stone being rolled away. Whatever your challenge is, give it to God who has the power to do all things (Ephesians 3:20). He has all the power to subdue the power and plans of enemies against you.

5. Resurrection power is the power that shuts all accusations down finally.

Elizabeth was being intimidated by her adversaries who called her barren, but the Lord finally shut them up with the power of resurrection by giving her a great son, read Luke 1:36.

How can you get the resurrection power?

The Resurrection Power is ONLY in the Name and Blood of Jesus Christ. Therefore, to get this power, you must:

1. Acknowledge your emptiness and give it all to Jesus. Don't be full of yourself in order for God to have a place in you.

2. Believe in the plan of redemption that God has paid the price to redeem us with the Blood of Jesus.

3. Come to Him by faith and believe that Jesus has redeemed you back to prosperity, read 2 Corinthians 8:9.

FINALLY BRETHERN, surrender your life to the Owner of the Resurrection Power and enjoy the power. 🙏

THE REVERSED IRREVERSIBLE² Jeremiah 32:27

Introduction

Convincing records in the Scriptures show how certain human impossibilities became possible by God's intervention. If it happened then, it will happen NOW because He is the same yesterday, today and forever – **Hebrews 13:8**. Today, we shall examine some characteristics of irreversible occurrences or statuses. In the end, we shall be able to clearly see our helplessness and ask for God's Hand of possibilities.

B. The Characteristics of Irreversibility

1. It speaks to common sense

Feeding over 5,000 people was practically impossible and does not match any common sense - **Matthew 14:17** and **John 6:7**. These are situations that define our limitation when it comes to the reversed irreversible. *If you can explain it, then it is no more miracle.*

2. It obeys the laws of nature

Peter could not understand or imagine the possibility of a reversal from death to life – one of the laws of nature - **Matthew 16:23**.

3. It is subject to details and order

Once a woman has menopause, by order and human details, she cannot give birth again. This was Sarah's sincere knowledge of the sequence of life which she agreed with - **Genesis 18:11-12**.

4. It points to facts

The message of the Second coming of Jesus Christ now appears mystical and never-going-to-happen to many souls (since the promise was made and to-date) saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of creation." **2 Peter 3:4-5**. *The difference between the Fact and the Truth is when it happens.*

5. It ends human attempts and efforts

Broken eggs or shattered plates are common human phenomena that show irreversible processes. The

story of the shipwreck, with Paul on board, in **Acts 27:27-44** illustrates this. But, hook unto God's Word in **Psalm 60:11** - Give us help from trouble: for vain is the help of man.

6. It is a sure consequence of actions

Irreversible situations are just like the laws of Medes and Persia – they are irrevocable; once you default, the consequence is sure and irreversible. This law was used to depose Queen Vashti (**Esther 1:9**) and was used against Daniel by King Darius – **Daniel 6:8,12**.

7. It is an Unchangeable Status

These are trans-generational patriarchal and matriarchal statuses. The Levites were answerable to God directly because they were selected among the tribes in Israel – **Numbers 3:12**. The same is true of certain royal patriarchal and matriarchal statuses in the Scriptures (**2 Chronicles 21:7**), and in our days.

8. It is an Expression of Impossibilities

John 3:4 – "What do you mean?" exclaimed Nicodemus. "How can an old man go back into his mother's womb and be born again?" At this juncture, it is common to say, 'it is a point of no return'. Human reasoning will quickly conclude a dead-end, just like the King's officer in **2 Kings 7:2**.

9. It Defines Perpetual Identity

When irreversibility becomes the daily experience, it redefines a man identity; usually the irreversible replaces his name. Bartimaeus - the Blind Bartimaeus (**Mark 10:46**), the Woman with the issue of blood – no name (**Matthew 9:20**) and the man born blind – **John 9**.
